

## English

This term, our work will be focused around 'The Stone Age Boy' and 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs'.

Children will:

- undertake a range of writing opportunities including instructions, non-chronological reports and persuasive letters.
- develop accurate use of spelling, punctuation and grammar including conjunctions (when, if, because, although), fronted adverbials, possessive apostrophes for plurals and identifying word classes.
- use correct spelling of key words and diagonal and horizontal strokes to join.

During guided reading the children will:

- develop their knowledge and understanding of the reading content domains.
- discuss word meaning, retrieve and record information, summarise, predict, make inferences and make comparisons within the text.



# Year 3 Autumn 2019

## Mathematics

Over the course of this term children will be focusing on number, place value, addition and subtraction as well as division and multiplication.

Children will:

- look at the value of each digit in a 3 digit number (hundreds, tens and ones).
- order and compare numbers.
- find 100 more and less than a given number.
- learn 3,4 and 8 times tables.
- use of a range of concrete resources to support their learning.
- learn how to use the written method accurately to solve a range of calculations which they will develop into their reasoning and problem solving.

## Science

In Science this half term, children will learn about plants.

Children will:

- identify what a plant needs to grow and the life cycle of a plant.
- identify different parts of a plant.
- planning and carrying out investigations.



## History/ Geography

History this half term will focus on the Stone Age to the Iron Age and Settlements .

Children will:

- use a range of historical evidence including timelines and maps.
- research and compare how life in the Stone Age and Iron Age compares to life in Britain today.
- explore different types of settlements using aerial maps to identify key features.



## Computing

The computer this half term will follow the Purple Mash scheme.

Children will:

- learn about keeping safe online.
- explore spreadsheets.

## Jigsaw



The PHSE this half term will focus on 'Being Me in My World'.

Children will:

- learn about taking responsibility for themselves and their learning.
- learn about rewards and consequences.

## RE



The RE this half term will focus on the celebration of Diwali.

Children will:

- discuss the festival of light,
- explore the food and traditions of different cultures.
- identify the key features of the religion.

## MFL

This half term in French, children will be learning how to:

- discuss different greetings

## Art/ DT

The Design and Technology work will focus on is 'vegetable soup'.

Children will :

- research different soups.
- plan, design, make and evaluate a vegetable soup.
- make cross curricular links with our literacy work, writing instructions.



## Music

The music this half term will follow the Cheranga scheme.

Children will:

- identify the structure of songs
- explore styles of music
- analyse performances.
