

## English

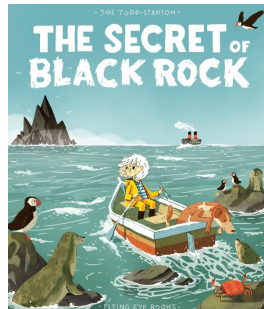
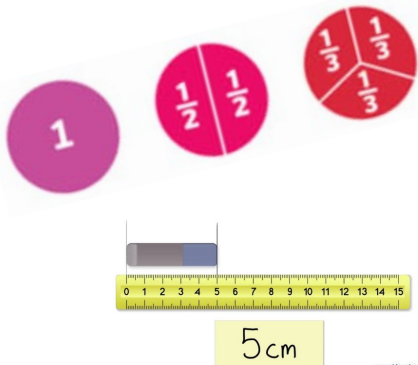
This term, our work will be focused around 'The secret of Black Rock'

Children will:

- undertake a range of writing opportunities including setting description, non chronological report and a narrative.
- applying knowledge of taught spelling patterns.
- continue to use basic punctuation and grammar including conjunctions (and, because) , suffixes and contractions.
- use correct spelling of key year 2 words and begin to use diagonal and horizontal strokes to join some letters.

During guided reading the children will:

- develop their knowledge and understanding of the reading content domains.
- discuss word meaning, retrieve and record information, and begin to predict and make inferences.



# Year 2 Spring 2019

## Mathematics

Over the course of this term children will be focusing on fractions and measure.

Children will:

- recognise, find, name and write fractions and of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity .
- write simple fractions and recognise the equivalence of one half and two quarters.
- choose and use standard units to estimate and measure length and height in any direction (m/cm); mass (kg/g); temperature (°C); capacity (litres/ml) to the nearest appropriate unit, using rulers, scales, thermometers and measuring vessels.
- compare and order lengths, mass, volume/capacity and record the results using >, < and =

## Science

In Science this term, children will learn about materials

Children will:

- Identify that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
- find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)
- describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

## History/ Geography

History this half term will focus on the Victorian era and Geography will focus on the UK, continents and oceans

Children will:

- use a range of historical evidence including timelines, maps and secondary sources to identify the Victorian empire, wealth and children's lives.
- Explore the lives of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole and how the changes they made impacts our lives today.



## Jigsaw

The PHSE this half term will focus on dreams and goals.

Children will:

- Discuss success, achievement, perseverance and working cooperatively.
- Identify who they work well with and how to work as an effective group.



## Art/ DT

The Art work will focus on creating skylines with watercolours.

Children will :

- identify how to create different strokes and shades.
- explore how colours can be used to create mood.
- explore how to create silhouettes.



## Music

The music this half term will follow the Cheranga scheme.

Children will:

- identify and follow a steady beat.
- listen and appreciate a range of different music types.
- use their voices expressively.

## Computing

The computing this half term will follow the Purple Mash scheme for using spreadsheets.

Children will:

- Navigate around the columns and rows of a spreadsheet.
- Enter data into cells and insert images.
