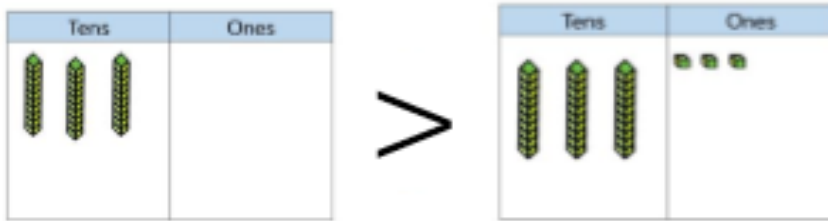

Reasoning

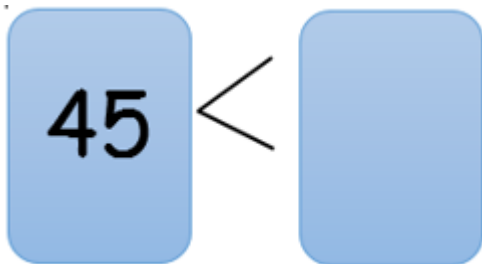
Ben compares two numbers.
