This week, your task is to talk to your grown ups or your siblings about what happens at the beginning, middle and end of a story. You could use a story you may have at home or maybe a story on MyOn online.

When talking about your story, try to talk in full sentences and think about the following:

- The beginning is the start of the story. Start with this.
- Move into talking about what happens at the end. This is to ensure that we have understood the language 'beginning' and 'end'.
- What happens in the middle of the story? Are there any key events/characters that make the story change?
- Can you use words such as 'first', 'next' and 'then'?

If you have finished that and want a challenge, maybe you could go and collect some things from your daily walk- such as daisies, sticks and leaves. You could use these to create pictures of the beginning, middle and end of your story.

I have lots of daisies on my front garden so I used them to create my name, can you write your name with things you can find?
