PRIMARY COLOURS

These three colours cannot be made by mixing other colours.

These are called primary colours.



red

yellow

blue

Red, yellow and blue are the three primary colours.

What are the secondary colours?



SECONDARY COLOURS

These three colours are made by mixing together two primary colours.

These are called secondary colours.



green

orange

purple

Green, orange and purple are the three secondary colours.

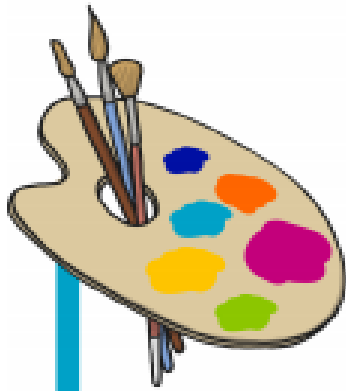
Do you remember when we mixed the primary colours to create the secondary colours?



SECONDARY COLOURS

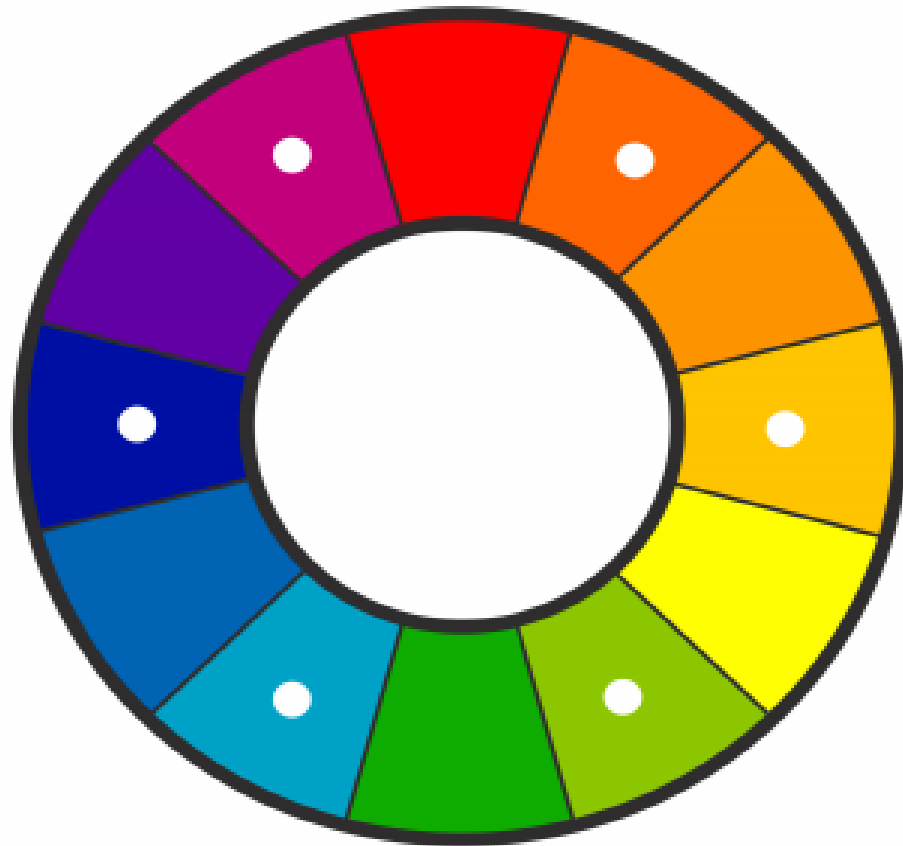
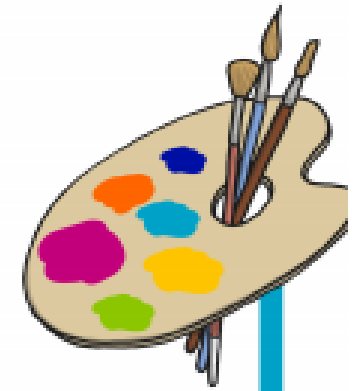
Secondary colours are made by mixing primary colours together.





TERTIARY COLOURS

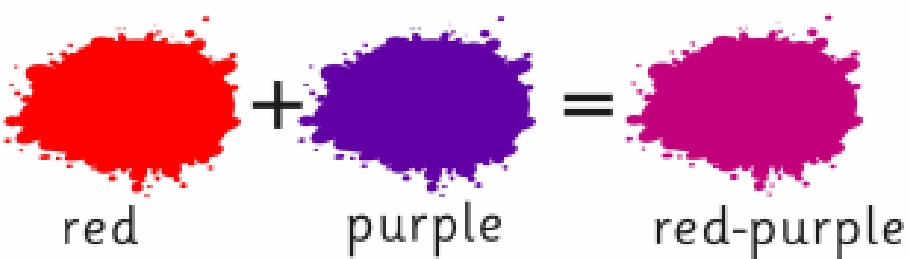
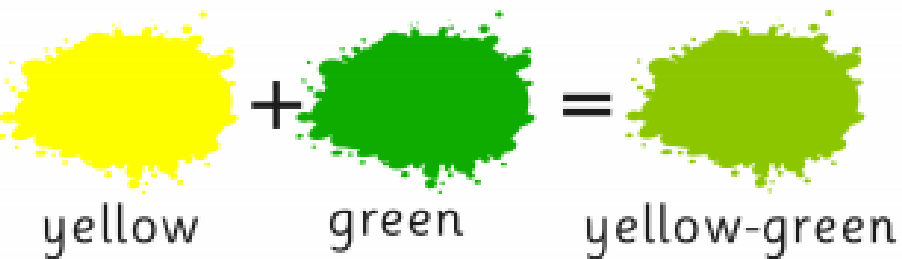
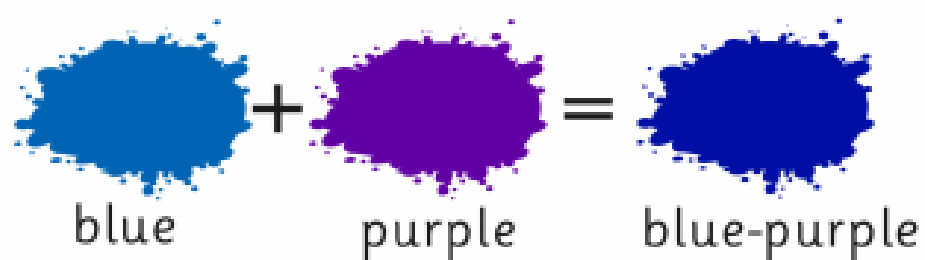
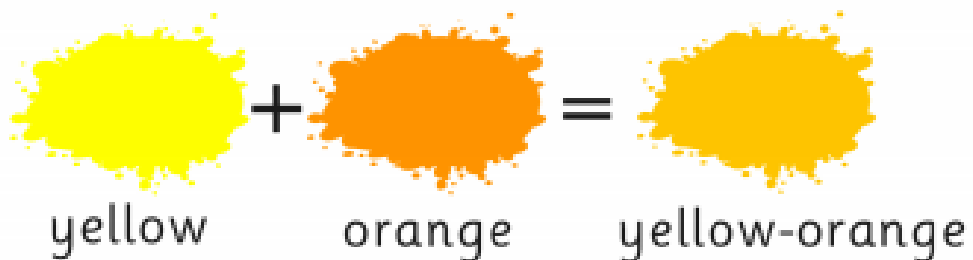
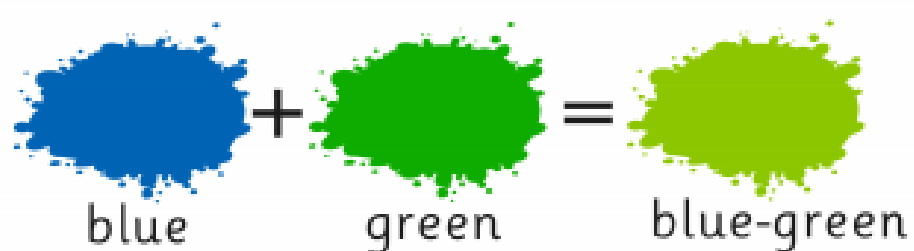
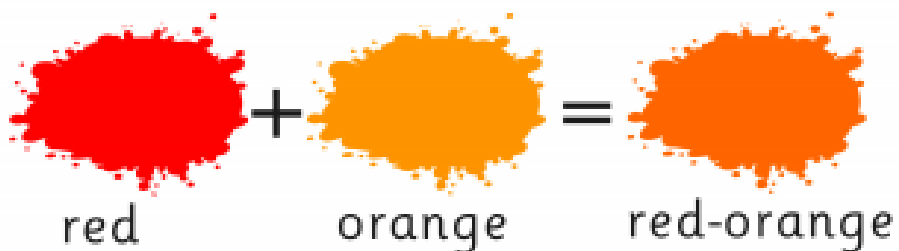
Here are combinations of **primary** and **secondary** colours mixed together.
