**Activity 1**

- In this unit, we will continue learning about 3D sculptures, including wire sculptures.
- Today we would like you to focus more on the design aspect of a wire sculpture.
- Public Art is usually symbolic (means something relevant and important to the place or people e.g. a wire sculpture in Birmingham could reflect the proud history of Birmingham's industry 'The city of 1000 trades', football such as B'ham City and Aston Villa, our rich Musical culture (UB40, Black Sabbath and Nigel Kennedy.) More trees than Paris and more canals than Venice!

This is how a sculptor can work in wire, tracing the wire around the outline of the shape/image to create their work. There is also a design process which must be followed! **1.** Decide upon a relevant design for YOU! Does it reflect your time and feelings about being at Wychall Primary School? **2.** List some ideas that are appropriate; think about how realistic and achievable your idea for a design is. **3.** Start a sketch or drawing in pencil. **4.** This is your Art so do not worry if you do not immediately get the exact result that you wish for. Try, try and try again! **5.** Reflect and evaluate. What works well? Could you alter and change the design? (Remember that you are in control-this is your Artwork!)
