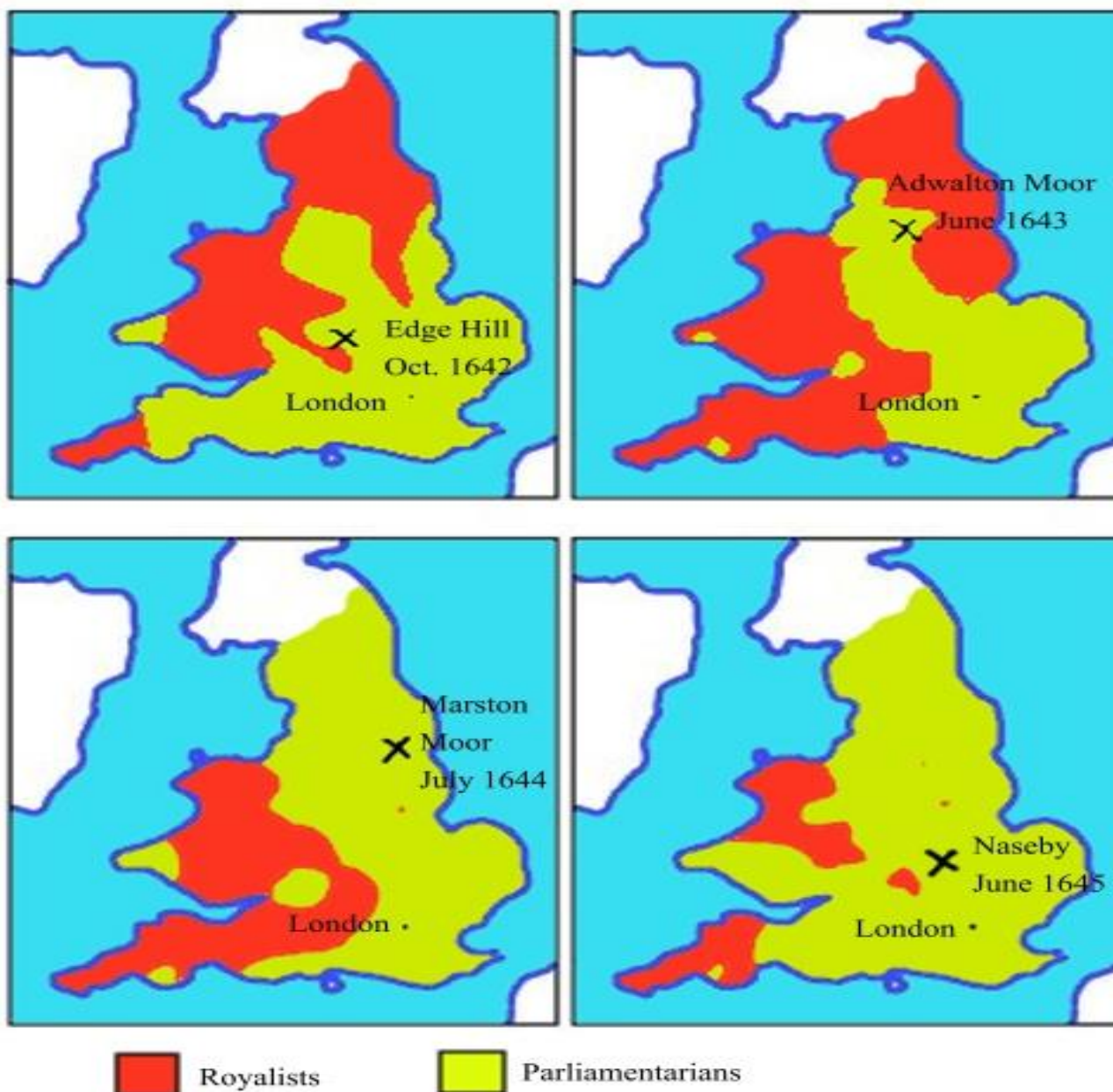


History week commencing 29th June 2020.
