



Remote Blended Learning Guide



How work is set?

Your child's work will be sent to you via text with a link to the learning platform Wakelet.

The majority of activities will have a Powerpoint or clip which will provide the information required for you to support your child to complete the tasks. There may also be, for example, a video clip of a story being read to your child, or a phonics session.

Once the introductory information has been viewed, the majority of the work set can be completed on paper. There may be exceptions to this e.g. the use of TT Rock Stars.

How to return work?

To return your child's work, you will need to use the Dojo App. Reminders of log-ins have been sent out to parents.

You will need to photograph your child's work and upload it to the Dojo APP. Please return work on a daily basis.

The work your child completes may be in a variety of forms, you may need to photograph:

- Your child completing an activity
- The work your child has completed on paper
- The computer screen with the completed work on (you do not need to print out the page to then photograph it)
- A piece of art work or a model
